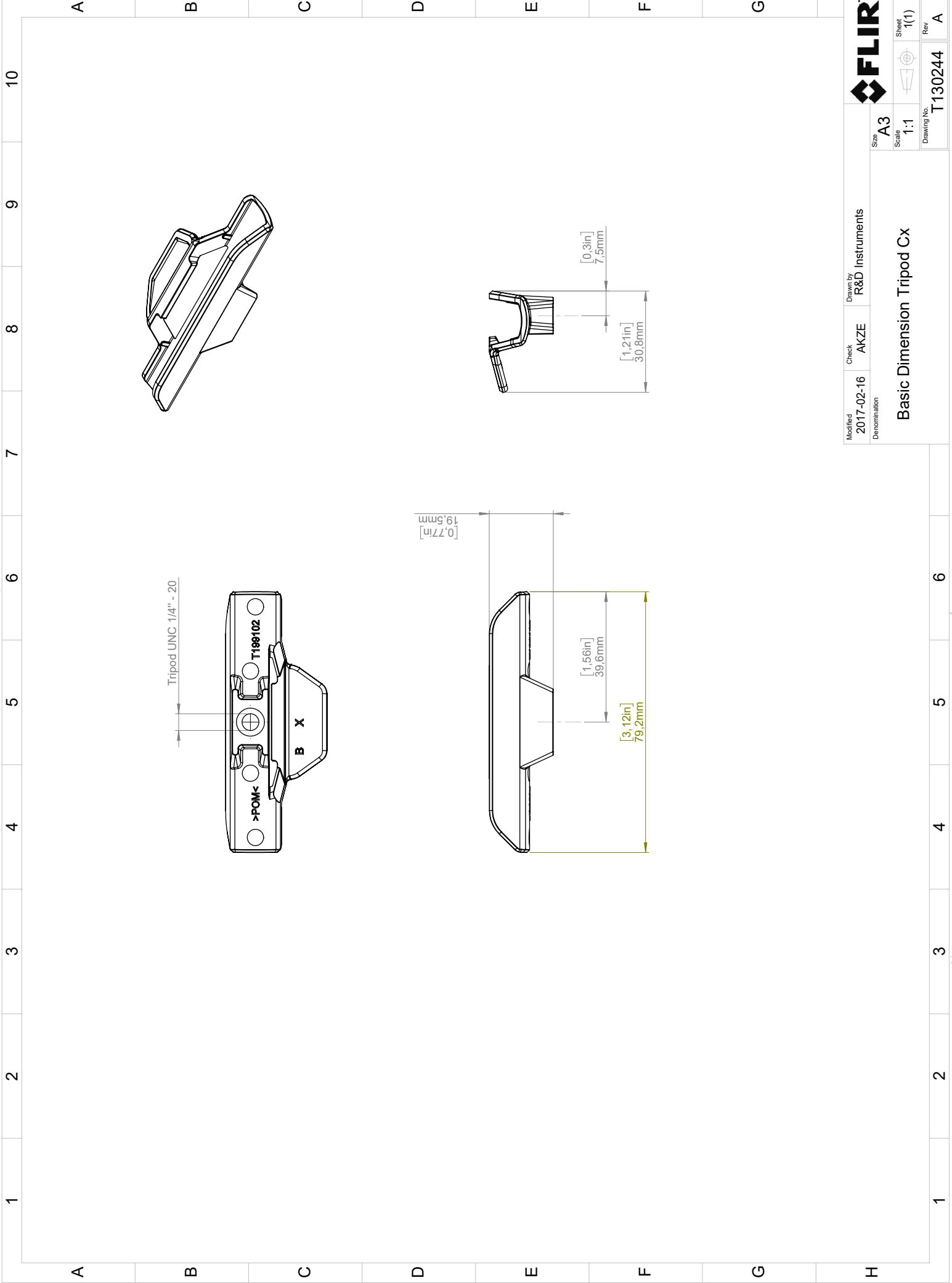


Visual Optical axis
